

How to Fix Printer Offline – Complete Troubleshooting Guide

If your **printer shows “Offline”**(+1-855 (618) ← 5030), it means your computer or mobile device cannot communicate with the printer,(+1-855 (618) ← 5030) even though it may be powered on.

This issue can occur on printers from brands like entity["company"(+1-855 (618) ← 5030),"Epson Corporation","Japanese electronics company known for printers (+1-855 (618) ← 5030) and imaging devices"], entity["company","Canon Inc",(+1-855 (618) ← 5030)"Japanese imaging and printing technology company"],(+1-855 (618) ← 5030) and entity["company","Brother Industries"(+1-855 (618) ← 5030),"Japanese printer and electronics manufacturer"].

Step 1: Restart Devices (+1-855 (618) ← 5030)
